Individual arrival in **Regensburg**. Embarkation on the RIVER CLOUD II at 16.00 hours.

Regensburg/Germany.

Nuremberg/Germany.

Arr.: 14.00 Dep.: 20.00

City tour*.

In the Middle Ages, Nuremberg was one of the most prosperous cities in Europe. Trade, art and culture flourished, and the city's famous landmark, Nuremberg Castle, was built during that time.

Fri. 15 Oct.

Bamberg/Germany.

Arr.: 06.00 Dep.: 13.00

City tour of Bamberg including its famous old town*.

Bamberg's historic town centre is the largest unspoilt old town in Germany. The old town hall built in the middle of the river is famous, but the town also has an unknown landmark – the Bamberg Horseman. In the afternoon, the RIVER CLOUD II glides along the Main.

Sat. 16 Oct.

Würzburg/Germany.

Arr.: 07.00 Dep.: 18.00

City tour with visit to the Residenz Palace*.

In the afternoon, excursion to the Juliusspital wine estate*.

The Marienberg Fortress and the Baroque Residenz with its extensive parkland sit high above the Main. The afternoon's excursion is to a traditional 450-year-old wine estate. At the core of the wine estate is its historic 250-metre-long oak-barrel cellar.

Sun. 17 Oct.

Miltenberg/Germany.

Arr.: 08.30 Dep.: 14.00

Tour of Miltenberg and excursion to Amorbach with organ concert*.

Miltenberg lies on the banks of the Main between the Spessart and Odenwald mountain ranges. The little town of Amorbach is not far from Miltenberg. It was built around the former Benedictine monastery, where the Stumm organ can be found.

Mon. 18 Oct.

The RIVER CLOUD II reaches the river Neckar, and glides upriver towards Heidelberg.

Heidelberg/Germany.

Arr.: 12.30 Dep.: 23.00

City tour of Heidelberg*.

Heidelberg has been a university town for centuries, and has, therefore, always remained young at heart. The beautiful old town and famous castle were legendary even by the 19th century.

Tue. 19 Oct.

Rüdesheim/Germany.

Arr.: 09.30 Dep.: 13.30

Tour of Eltville and trip to Kiedrich*.

Eltville is situated in the Rheingau wine region, and so everything revolves around wine here. The village of Kiedrich, known locally as a "Gothic treasure trove", is considerably smaller. The boat then sets off past the romantic river banks of the Middle Rhine and the legendary Loreley rock.
